### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

### **COVERING ORIGINAL AND HT VERSIONS**

### **USE**

For profiling around irregular shaped pipe fittings particularly where deep fillings are required. It is used with primer prior to overwrapping with DENSO™, DENSOPOL™ or DENSOCLAD TAPES™ for the long term corrosion protection of buried pipe fittings.

### **SURFACE PREPARATION**

Surfaces must be clean, dry and dust-free. Remove all loose rust, scale and flaking coatings by scraping, wire brushing or blast cleaning.

### **PRIMING**

Apply appropriate primer for tape (e.g. DENSO PASTE<sup>TM</sup> or DENSO<sup>TM</sup> HI-TACK PRIMER for DENSO TAPE<sup>TM</sup> or DENSO PRIMER D<sup>TM</sup> for DENSOPOL<sup>TM</sup> or DENSOCLAD<sup>TM</sup> cold applied laminate tapes). Apply DENSO PASTE<sup>TM</sup> by gloved hand, DENSO<sup>TM</sup> HI-TACK PRIMER or DENSO PRIMER D<sup>TM</sup> by brush in a thin layer over the entire surface including threads, crevices and pitted areas.


### **APPLICATION**

Press DENSO™ PROFILING MASTIC into cavities, angles and around bolt heads to form a profile suitable for wrapping with tape without forming bridges or voids.

### **OVERWRAPPING**

DENSO™ PROFILING MASTIC must be wrapped with an anti-corrosion tape to complete protection. See 'Instructions for Use' or the particular tape.

### **COVERING ORIGINAL AND HT VERSIONS**

### **STORAGE**

Store correct way up in original packaging. Store in a cool dry place away from heat and open flames.

### **TRANSPORT**

No special precautions necessary.

### **HANDLING**

- Grease resistant gloves are advised to reduce skin contact.
- Avoid contact with arms and face etc.
- Wash thoroughly with soap and water after use and before work breaks to remove compound from the skin.
- Careful attention should be given to personal hygiene.
- Change and clean soiled clothing.

### **ACTION IN CASE OF...**

**FIRE:** Extinguish with dry powder, carbon dioxide or chemical foam. Use air breathing equipment in case of large fires in confined spaces.

**SKIN CONTACT:** Wash with warm water and mild soap. **EYE CONTACT:** Irrigate eyes thoroughly with clean water. **SWALLOWING:** Obtain medical advice if necessary.
